Spring Term 1 Learning Letter 2023

In English this half term we will read and explore stories on our capital city of London. In our first story 'The Queen's Hat' we will learn to describe 'The Queen' using our best adjectives and our learning from Jubilee Week. We will read and re-write the story of 'The Queen's Handbag' and then compare it to the story of 'The Queen's Hat' in a book comparison. Finally, we will write a description of Paddington Bear and write a recipe and party invitation to a tea with him.

In Maths we will continue to learn how to add and subtract numbers up to 20. We will learn about the value of numbers up to 50 and begin to count up to and from 50.

We will continue our work on one more and one less up to 50 and order numbers within 50. We will also learn how to count in 2's and 5's.

We will also learn how to measure length, height, weight and volume.

In Art we are learning to create a collage. We will study the work of a famous painter called Monet who painted landmarks of London. We will study the techniques of collage and think about the materials we can use to create different effects. We will then use our skills to create a collage of a London Landmark.

Our Learning Theme is ... 'Great Britain'



In RE we are learning all about the Muslim faith. We will recognise and describe objects that are precious to Muslims and understand why the stories in the Quran are important to Muslims. We will learn all about what happens at mosque and share our own experiences.

In Geography we will study the location of the UK on a world map and then learn the four countries and capital cities of the UK. We will learn the names of the surrounding seas and think about the seas we need to cross to get to other places. We will sort physical and human features of Wales, Scotland and England and write about what we have learnt in an information poster.

In Science we are learning about animals and their different characteristics. We will look at the similarities between mammals, fish, amphibians, birds and reptiles. We will also talk about the animals we know and if they are wild animals or if they are pets.

In RHE/ PSHE we will be learning about Keeping safe. We will learn about a range of different safety measures we can take to keep safe including medicine safety, sun safety, road safety, e-safety and personal and emotional safety. We will also learn that having enough rest can make us feel better and improve our emotional safety.
