

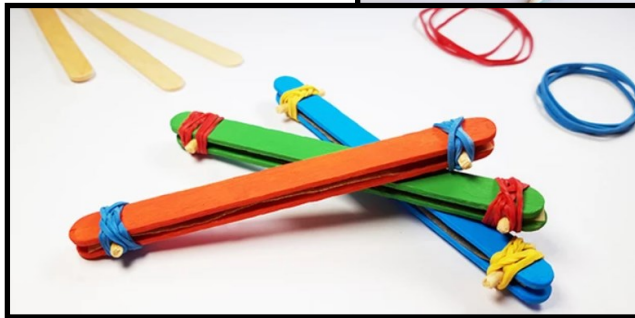
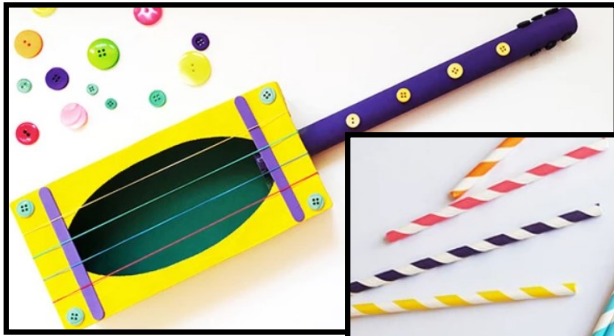
# Year 4 Home Learning Project
