## **Spring Term Learning Letter 2025**

In English we are learning to write a letter based on the book 'Meerkat Mail'. We will use adjectives, time connectives and conjunctions and work hard on our spelling strategies. We will also write a story from another culture based on the book 'Lila and the Secret of the Rain'. We will write a non-chronological report based on African animals.

In Maths we will continue our addition and subtraction work. We will revisit our time work and practice telling the time on the clock to quarter past quarter to and half past and try to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

We will begin to understand statistics by collecting data in tally charts, making pictograms and interpreting them.

**In Art** we will perfect our sculpture skills.

We will be making an African mask, using our own designs.

We will research other artists designs to give us ideas and plan the process out.

# Our Learning Theme is ... 'Africa'

**In RE** we will be learning about the Muslim faith.

We will talk about why the Quran is important and the story of Eid UI Fitr. We will name Muslim artefacts and use drama to act out what the laws of the Quran teach us.

**In Geography** we will be learning all about the continent 'Africa'. We will start by locating and naming the 7 continents of the world.

We will learn all about Kenya and study the culture, climate, animals and facts about it. We will label maps and write sentences to record what we have learnt.

In Science we will learn all about growing and changing animals. We will learn the names of baby animals and compare their growth to the human life cycle. We will think about the rates we grow and investigate if the oldest in our class is the tallest. We will study the frog life cycle in depth and use our best writing skills to explain it.

**In RHE/ PSHE** we will be thinking about how we grow and change linking this learning to our science lessons.

Please share your child's reading book with them, as <u>10-15 minutes</u> of reading <u>every day</u> at home can make a lot of difference to your child's reading ability.


Your child MUST bring their book bag into school <u>every day</u> so an adult can read with them on their reading day, and any extra days if there is an opportunity.
